

## **SSC Highlights from OPERATION ORDER 11-06-019 Fort Jackson Fall Clean-Up 2011**

**Mission.** USATC and Fort Jackson conducts annual Fall Clean-Up of the cantonment and training areas from 11 October 2011- 18 November 2011 in order to provide a clean and healthy environment for Soldiers, Service members, Family members, Fort Jackson Civilians and guests.

**Commander's Intent.** Beautify Fort Jackson Installation cantonment, training and community areas with maximum participation from all. Every occupant has a personal responsibility for the upkeep and beautification of their environment. This supports Fort Jackson Campaign Plan 3.0 Quality of Life and 5.0 Support and Sustainability.

**End State:** USATC and Fort Jackson units successfully executed a post-wide clean-up to beautify the cantonment, training, and community areas.

### **Single Soldier Complex Requirements**

- The designated dates and times for Single Soldiers to be released to their residences (Single Soldiers Complex) for Fall Clean-Up is 16 November 2011 from 0900-1600. The Garrison and BDE Command Sergeant Majors will inspect the Single Soldier Complex to ensure the standards are met on 18 November 2011 at 1400. Units are responsible for the following buildings: Bldg 2446-DENTAC, Bldg 2442-MEDDAC, Bldg 2453-WTU, Bldg 2449-193rd, Bldg's 2460 and Bldg 2461-171st IN, Bldg 2467-MPs/SSI and Bldg 2468-165th IN.
- Soldiers living in Single Soldiers Complex will clean their area of responsibility and assist in cleaning of common areas. **On their scheduled day, Soldiers will be released from duty after physical training (PT) to participate in Fall Clean-Up. The Single Soldier Complex will be their place of duty.**
- Edge lawns along walks, driveways, roadside curbs, shrub beds, and other places where necessary to present a neat appearance. Remove grass in between cracks in walkways, driveways and along roadside curbs.
- Parking lots will be policed of trash, leaves, grass clippings, pine straw, etc. Clean up any grease, oil stains or spills on driveways and parking lot pavements. A 3 foot diameter around each tree will be left undistributed. Do not rake pine straw onto the 3 foot diameter.
- Parking lot in the Single Soldiers Complex will be closed on 17 November 2011 from 0900-1500. Ensure all vehicles are removed from the parking lots beforehand.
- Sweep common areas to include stairways, breezeways, etc. and wipe down hand rails.
- Weed flower beds.

### **Restrictions.**

- It is illegal in South Carolina to dispose of cut grass, leaves, pine straw, tree limbs, or other yard waste in a dumpster, roll-off bin, herbie-curbie, or any other trash container intend for disposal at a municipal solid waste landfill. **Units and activities must transport their yard waste to the Mulch Site on Hartsville Guard.**
- Soil, sand, and rocks will not be placed in a disposal container such as a dumpster or herbie-curbie.
